Entertainment Category - Selection of music must be pop. (Broadway, Movies, TV, etc.)

This category is strictly non classical. A 30 second speech is required and not included in the time limit. The speech will account for 10% of the total score. Contestants may present either published music, manuscript, or a lead sheet. Photo copies are permitted. Music may be used. Contestants may dress according to the theme of the selection they have chosen. Judging is based on overall presentation. Cash prizes plus trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place in both "Junior" & "Senior" Categories.

Piano Contestants May Enter The Following:

Open Classical Solo - (may use same selection in "Virtuoso") (may not use a selection from the standard list)

Standard Classical Solo - (must use a selection from the standard list.)

Open Pop Solo - (may use same selection in "Entertainment" category).(may not use a selection from the standard list).

Virtuoso Solo - (may use same selection as in "Open Classical")

Standard Pop Solo - (must use a selection from the standard list).

Open Ragtime Solo - (may not use a selection from the standard list).

Standard Ragtime Solo - (must use a selection from the standard list).

Open Jazz Solo - (may not use a selection from the standard list).

Standard Jazz Solo - (must use a selection from the standard list).

Entertainment Solo - (may use same selection in "Open Pop").

Sight Reading Solo

Open Duet - (may not use a selection from the standard list).

Standard Duet - (must use a selection from the standard list).

Evaluation Solo - (may use same selection as in any competitive category).

Evaluation Duet - (may use same selection as in any duet category).

All Time Limits are on the Application.

All contestants are allowed a 10 second warm up.
